

EDITORIAL NOTES.

The first number of the Bulletin, which appeared in 1933, was for the most part historical, and contained a concise review of the activities of the Association during the first ten years of its existence.

Having by this means brought our records up to date, it has become possible to introduce in the present number accounts by several of our members of expeditions undertaken by them, at home and in the Alps, during the past year. Reports of the proceedings of the Association, both indoor and outdoor, have also been given in greater detail.

No records of new rock climbs have reached us, but many climbs of every degree of difficulty and interest have been made by our members during the year. A number of members have also spent holidays abroad. Although reports of some of these have not been received, it may be mentioned that Miss Kemp and Miss Jackson were in Central Norway, a party including Wallace May and G. A. Lister were in Austria, and Walter Meakin was in Bulgaria; whilst amongst ascents made in the Alps, in addition to those described, were the North Face of the Breithorn by E. O. Ransome, the Zmutt Arête by M. S. Taylor, a traverse of the Grépon by J. H. Sheldon, and a guideless traverse of the Meije by G. F. Peaker.

Members are invited to supply particulars of future expeditions or lists of climbs for a forthcoming number of the Bulletin.

During the year the Association has been represented at a number of the Annual Dinners of Kindred Clubs, and our thanks are due to these Clubs for the generous hospitality with which our representatives have invariably been received.

The Association was invited to send a representative to the fourth International Congress of Alpinism, held at Cortina in September, 1933, and although it was not actually represented, the Association was officially included amongst the adherents thereto.
